

# **Guidelines for Private Swim Instructors Teaching Swim Lessons at Carpenter Village Pool**

## **GOALS FOR PRIVATE SWIM INSTRUCTORS**

1. To provide a safe and comfortable environment for all swimmers
2. To teach all swimmers safety in and around the water
3. To provide quality instruction that improves the skills and development of the student

## **REQUIREMENTS FOR ALL PRIVATE SWIM INSTRUCTORS**

1. At all times while within the Carpenter Village Pool facility, each instructor must abide by all policies, regulations, and rules found in the current Carpenter Village Pool Handbook. The handbook may be found under Pool Committee documents on the official Carpenter Village web site.
2. Instructor must be at least 16 years of age.
3. Instructor must have current Lifeguard Certification. Proof of certification must be provided to the Pool Committee.
4. Instructor must provide a schedule of ALL lessons offered at Carpenter Village Pool, including student/parent names and addresses, to be used for membership verification. Only CV Pool members may enter into these contracts.
5. INSTRUCTOR/STUDENT/PARENT REQUIREMENTS:
  - a. Instructor shall individually Contract with Parent of Student for Lessons and Payment
  - b. Instructor shall require Parent-completion of the CV HOA Private Swim Lessons Waiver
  - c. Instructor shall provide signed CV HOA Private Swim Lessons Waiver to Pool Committee
  - d. Instructor shall require Parent or Guardian to remain at the pool during the entire lesson
  - e. Instructor may require Parent-completion of a Satisfaction Report, provided by Instructor

## **CV HOA PRIVATE SWIM LESSON GUIDELINES**

1. Private Lessons may be offered on the basis of one student per class any time the pool is open.
2. Private Lessons may not take place during unguarded hours.
3. Private Lessons may not take place during the 10-minute adult swim break.
4. Lap Swimmers have priority over lessons.
5. Group Lessons are not permitted at any time.
6. Lifeguards/pool staff reserve the right to refuse any lesson for reasons including, but not limited to, safety and overcrowding of the pool.

**Any disregard of the guidelines set forth in this document could result in the revocation of pool privileges.**
